The Center for Energy Policy and Management (CEPM) is a part of Washington & Jefferson College (W&J) in Washington, PA. Formed in 2012, the Center specializes in helping students, faculty, staff, non-profit leaders, and public officials in the region learn about important issues related to energy and sustainability.

This summer, the Center invites local high school students to take part in its first-ever Green Building and Design Summer Institute. Supported by the FirstEnergy and Claude Worthington Benedum Foundations, the program will introduce students to the basics of architecture, buildings, construction, design, and energy.

Through hands-on activities, field trips, guest speakers, and one-on-one connections with W&J students and professors, students will have the opportunity to learn about current and emerging careers related to green buildings and design in our region.

The program will run June 12-23, 2023, Monday through Friday. The program begins at 9 am and concludes at 2 pm each day on W&J's campus. There is no cost to students or families. Lunch will be provided to students for free. Families are responsible for transportation to and from the program.

THE PROGRAM


